FOR RURAL AREAS, SMALL CITIES OR SMALL URBANIZED AREAS HAVING USDOT/FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION PROGRAMS ADMINISTERED BY THE STATE:

Any person or group protected by Title VI who believes they have been discriminated against with regard to the delivery of public or specialized transportation services may file a signed written complaint with the Office of Transportation Delivery of the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet within 180 days of the date of the alleged discrimination.

A signed written complaint should include:

- Your name, address, telephone number and signature
- The name and address of the transit agency or transportation program you believe discriminated against you.
- How, why and when you believe you were discriminated against and the names of those involved, if known. Include as much background information as possible about the alleged act(s) of discrimination.
- The names of any persons that OTD can contact for additional information to support or clarify your allegations.
